

Minutes
Called Meeting
January 14, 2020

The Tattnall County Board of Commissioners held a Called Meeting on Tuesday, January 14, 2020, at 9:30 A.M. at the Tattnall County Courthouse, 108 Brazell Street, Reidsville, Georgia 30453. The purpose of the Called Meeting was:

1. Approve Agenda
2. Road closing for District 4: Close a portion of the Kennedy Road at the end of Laddie Kennedy Road. Latitude and Longitude of 31.97254333-82.05169833.
3. Appoint Tattnall County Industrial Development Authority Board Members
4. Take care of other items needing attention
5. Executive Session if needed

Members absent: Commissioner Edward Kennedy.

Chairman Trim called the Meeting to order at 9:30 a.m., led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave the invocation.

1) Chairman Trim presented the agenda for approval.

There was a motion by Commissioner Bill Kicklighter and 2nd by Commissioner Bobby Kennedy to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

2) Chairman Trim then presented road closure of District 4 to be advertised as follows: Close a portion of the Kennedy Road at the end of Laddie Kennedy Road. Latitude and Longitude of 31.97254333-82.05169833.

This road is being added to the list of road closures and changes to be advertised.

There was a motion by Commissioner Wayne Tatum and 2nd by Commissioner Bill Kicklighter to approve advertisement to close a portion of the Kennedy Road at the end of Laddie Kennedy Road. Latitude and Longitude of 31.97254333-82.05169833. The motion further approves to

advertise road closure request in the local new organ on January 16th, 23rd and 30th with a Public hearing to be held on January 30, 2020 at 10 a.m. at the Courthouse. Motion carried unanimously.

There was a motion by Commissioner GW Thompson and 2nd by Commissioner Bobby Kennedy to appoint and approve TCIDA Members and Officers as listed above. Motion carried unanimously.

4) Commissioner Bill Kicklighter inquired with Board of Elections Chairman, Dennis Odom regarding the new voting machines. Mr. Odom stated Mrs. Pam Waters will be printing an article in the newspaper advising citizens of new voting machine on site at Board of Elections office that can be tested prior to Election.

Mr. Odom explained that these new machines will print a ballot that the citizen will have to scan in on a scanner on site. There will be one scanner and several voting machines at each voting precinct. He also commented that extra staff will be at each voting precinct to assist citizens if needed. Mr. Odom then stated all equipment and precincts are ready for the upcoming election and IT contractor, Jamey Vickery will be onsite to assist also.

5) With no further items requiring attention, there was a motion by Commissioner Bobby Kennedy and 2nd by Commissioner Bill Kicklighter to adjourn the meeting at 9:39 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
